BANK STATEMENT/EVIDENCE OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

F-1 international students are required to show evidence of the financial support that was indicated on page 2. Such evidence is typically provided through current bank statements or bank letters.

Financial document guidelines:

- Must be dated within the last six months;
- The name of the bank and of the account holder must be included;
- The current total account balance must be shown (we cannot accept a letter indicating “good customer”, “adequate funds”, or “balance in the low six figures”);
- The type of currency must be indicated;
- The type of account (e.g. savings, checking, time deposit) must be indicated;
- Must be in English, or include a certified English translation.
- Letters of financial guarantee from government or other institutional sponsors must include the name of the award recipient, state the period of time covered by the award, and indicate SPU as the student’s authorized institution of attendance.
- Personal sponsors other than immediate family members will be required to submit an additional letter of support. Information about the content of this letter will be provided by SPU International Admissions.

2022–23 ESTIMATED ANNUAL COSTS

All costs are listed in U.S. dollars and assume full-time enrollment for a nine-month academic year.
